Speaker: Dr. Donna Sinclair
Title: African American Contributions to the Civilian Conservation Corps

From 1932 until 1942, the Civilian Conservation Corps, or CCC was one of the largest public works programs of the New Deal. The program employed single young men to perform unskilled manual labor in jobs related to the conservation and development of natural resources on federal, state and local government lands. About 200,000 African Americans were employed by the CCC. Their story has been largely forgotten. Dr. Donna Sinclair will discuss the work and conditions of these camps, the program's benefits and drawbacks for African Americans, and the shift from integrated to segregated camps.

GRANDE VOITURE du WASHINGTON CALL TO THE GRANDE PROMENADE

Pasco, Washington, June 8, June 9, June 10, 2018

OFFICIAL CALL TO THE, GRANDE VOITURE du WASHINGTON, LA SOCIETE DES QUARANTE (40) HOMMES et HUIT (8) CHEVAUX, pursuant to the Constitution and Bylaws of the Grande Voiture du Washington, on June 8, thru June 10, 2018 at Pasco Washington.

PURPOSE: The Grande Promenade is called for the purpose of electing officers for the ensuing term, amending the Constitution of Grande Voiture, the election of delegates and alternates to the Promenade Nationale and for the transaction of such other business as may come before it.

BASIS OF REPRESENTATION: In accordance with Article VI, Section 3, Grande Voiture Constitution, each Voiture Locale shall be entitled to one (1) Delegate at large and one (1) additional delegate for each twenty-five (25) members or major fraction thereof, as shown by the records of the Grande Voiture Correspondant within fifteen (15) days preceding the Grande Promenade.

The preliminary roll call will be made at the close of business, June 8, 2018, Based on the membership reports, received by the Grande Correspondant, from Correspondant Nationale, up to and including the above DATE. Voiture Locales indebted to either Voiture Nationale or the Grand Voiture will not be included in this Roll Call and may not seat delegates in the Grand Promenade.

CONTESTS: Should any Voiture Locale be denied credentials or claim more delegates than allowed them in the preliminary Roll Call, it may present its claim to the Credentials Committee for consideration and decision.

CREDENTIALS: Will be mailed by the Grand Correspondant on April 20th, 2018, to each Correspondant Locale. Credentials must be counter signed by the Chef de Gare and Correspondant Locale and given to the accredited delegates and alternates of each Voiture.

VOTING: Voting at the Grande Promenade will be by Roll Call. Only delegates are entitled to vote. Each Voiture should designate a Chairperson of


