I have two Associate Degrees; One from the Community College of the Air Force and one from Columbia College as well as my Baccalaureate Degree. In November 1995 ITT Technical Institute; I had the position as a Instructor for one quarter, then I was moved to Education Supervisor in Automated Manufac-


others. It can be a paragraph or full page. A photo would nice to go with it. I know this is a lot to ask but let's face it each and everyone of you deserves recognition for your service.


