La Femmes 5th Anniversary

In September 2011 Promenade Nationale and Rendezvous Nationale were held in Vancouver hosted by Voiture 99 and Grande du Washington. One of the local wives was curious about the La Femmes and looked into starting a Cabane in Vancouver. She was initiated into the La Femmes during the Vancouver Rendezvous Nationale so she could attend the meetings and talk to the members.

Many questions and answers later Cabane 99 was formed and 11 Dames signed the charter. The 11 charter signers are the Dames without which we would not have Cabane 99. The founding Dames are Roberta Giesler, Judy Bailey, Alice Kadow, Marsha Keen, Elaine Meis, Carol Perrin, Sylvia Ridout, Sharon Shattuck, Anita Stadey, JoAnn Strickland, and Linda Tarbell.

The first year all of the charter members had an elected office and there were not many members in the audience. By the end of that first year there were 24 dames in Cabane 99. We ended last year at almost 50 dames and have been at 100% every year.

La Societe de Femme was formed in 1963 solely to support the programs and principles of the 40 et 8. In that spirit Cabane 99 worked hard to come up with ways to support Voiture 99 and the 40 et 8 in general. In 5 years there have been some successes such as the help we give the VA Transplant Lodge. We help serve some of the dinners held here. Any tips go to Voiture programs. We help decorate the Chateau for the winter holiday season. We help with set up for the Passé Chef's dinner, and sometimes other events.

It took us a while to gear up, but our Holiday Bazaar, Used Book Sale, and Rummage Sale earn money for Nurses Training, Child Welfare, and Nationale Programs. The proceeds from the Car Show food concession go to the Voiture 99 Veterans Assistance program. We have some annoying habits such as selling 50/50 raffle tickets, but 50% of the proceeds go to the winner and the rest goes to pay our bills. So far we are debt free and have given over \$31,000 to Voiture Programs and the VA Transplant Lodge in 5 years.

It is an honor to give back to Voiture 99 since we would not be where we are without the help of the Voyageurs of Voiture 99. Cabane 99 is a young organization, but with the good example of Voiture 99 to follow we are looking forward to the next 5 years and beyond.
