Correspondants Notes

I had the opportunity to sit in at a Veterans Roundtable on November 18, 2017 here at the Chateau hosted by Congresswoman Jaime Herrera Beutler. The Congresswoman was accompanied by U. S. Representative Phil Roe, MD., who is Chairman of the U. S. House Committee on Veterans Affairs. Representative Roe talked at length about the VA in general and the changes that have taken place since his association with the House Committee on Veterans Affairs. He also addressed many of the problems that are ongoing not only here in SW Washington, but throughout all VA Centers across the Nation.

There were representatives present from just about all of the service organizations located in the Southwest Washington area. While the program was orchestrated to some small degree, each organization, or member of that organization, had a chance to address problems that they personally experienced while dealing with the VA here in SW Washington and at the Portland campus or were told about because of their status as a Service Officer. There were a few things identified which up until now, I don't think anyone ever considered before.

One such item is having those individuals who review claims gain a better understanding of the use of military language as it pertains to the way different military organizations function. This can and has caused confusion which has led to the refusal of claims in the past and continues to do so. Other areas which continue to be a problem are: too many claims still being lost/misplaced in the system and it still takes too long to process a claim or even receive medications.

The general consensus seemed to be that the

overall system is big, slow and cumbersome. Changes are happening, but they too are slow in the process. The good news is that the Service Officers and veterans in the SW Washington area were afforded the opportunity to express their concerns to the Chairman of the House Committee on Veterans Affairs and to Representative Beutler directly.

For the Voiture; we are entering the last month of the year and there are still many of you who have not renewed your dues for 2018. Why not take a moment and ask yourself one simple question. Why did you join this organization in the first place? Our values and goals have not changed. The programs, services and funding 40/8 provides to Youth Organizations, Veterans and programs like nursing scholarships are still our main objectives. We need your membership, help and participation if we are to succeed. The dues have not changed – they are still only \$25.00 for the year. We can accomplish so much with that \$25.00.






