

Correspondants Notes, cont.

Commissaire Intendant. Chief Financial Officer of the The C.I. oversees all Voiture. accounts and is the guardian of our treasury. The C.I. accepts and disburses all funds supporting the operations of the Voiture to include fund raising activities. The C.I. maintains accurate records of all receipts and disbursements. Although not specifically required, it is beneficial to have a background with a higher technical level of accounting and experience with the principals of financial management than the average individual. The C.I. oversees the annual budget and provides such reporting as necessary to satisfy Voiture and higher financial and government reporting requirements. The C.I. will cause an audit of all Voiture property to be conducted annually and the results presented to the Chef de Gare. There are many other aspects of this position not covered here. Contact the Intendant Commissaire for further information about this position.

Correspondant.

The Correspondant is the secretary for the Voiture. As such, will provide complete and accurate records of all Cheminots, Promenades and records of all proceedings. Maintain currant and accurate lists of all officers and committee chairs as well as the current membership of the Voiture. Providing current membership

cards for all renewed and/or new members. Provide change of addresses to Nationale as well as all death notices. Be familiar with the content and spirit of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Voiture Locale, Grand Du and Nationale. This is but a brief overview of this position. 


