Correspondants Notes

Questions have been raised regarding the functions and makeup of the Cheminot which need to be clarified. The Cheminot serves in the same capacity as the board of directors would in any corporation. The Cheminot may establish such committees as necessary to support the operation and functions of the Voiture provided those committees established do not interfere with the permanent committees established by the Constitution. The primary function of the Cheminot is to insure the Voiture is functioning in accordance with our Constitution and by-laws; to oversee our financial activities and to maintain a safe environment for all voiture functions.

The Cheminot shall meet once a month at a place and time designated by the Chef de Gare. A special meeting of the Cheminot may be called at the written request of five voting members, stating the time, place and subject matter of the meeting. Only that subject matter may be addressed. These advanced requirements may be waived in the event of emergencies involving immediate health or safety hazards, or potential loss or damage to equipment or property.

The Cheminot is made up of the following: Chef de Gare, Chef de Train, Commissaire Intendant, Correspondant and six Cheminot members at large, each serving a three year term with two new members elected each year. The Chef de Gare will exercise his vote only in the case of a tie vote. Each Passé Chef de Gare, in good standing, shall be a nonvoting member of the Cheminot. Any voyageur of Voiture 99, in good standing, may address the Cheminot.

All motions presented to the Cheminot must be presented by a Cheminot member and seconded by a Cheminot member. The discussion may be entered by nonvoting members and voyageurs in general upon recognition by the Chef de Gare. However, only Cheminot members may vote on any given motion presented.

All action taken by the Cheminot shall be subject to ratification at the next Promenade.


